(MALE CANDIDATES) IN BSF**

// ADDENDUM //

The Ministry of Home Affairs have been issued revised scheme regarding recruitment of Constable/General Duty (Male) in BSF. The following events have been introduced in revised scheme during selection procedure for the post of CT/GD (Male) in BSF advertised by the Dy Inspector General, Training Centre and School during the month of June 2009 to fill-up 413 vacancies :-

- (a) At the very beginning of recruitment process, candidates whose applications are found to be in order will be asked to go through the height bar and thereby, candidates with lesser height will be eliminated.
- (b) The candidate who qualify the height test will be subjected to 5 kilometers race to be completed within 24 minutes.
- (c) The procedure to obtain thumb impression, digital photographs and any specific identifying mark of the body will be taken in respect of those candidates who qualify in the race.
- (d) Testimonials of the candidates will be checked after the identification process and only eligible candidates will go the next step.
- (e) Physical Standard Test (PST)
Candidates who are found eligible on screening of testimonials will be screened first for height, chest and weight measurements by a board before sending them for PET.
- (f) Physical Efficiency Test (PET)
The candidates who clear PST, will be required to undergo PET. PETs consist of the following :-
 - (i) 11 Ft long jump (three chances to be given).
 - (ii) 3 ½ Ft high jump (three chances to be given).
 - (iii) No physical efficiency test will be held for Ex-servicemen. However, Ex-servicemen will be required to pass the requisite medical examination.
 - (iv) Physical Efficiency Test will not be only qualifying in nature and it will not carry any marks.

(iii) While all the question papers in an examination may contain the same set of questions, the question papers may be in different series, which will have the question in different order.

(iv) The question paper will be set to assess the general awareness/ general knowledge, knowledge of elementary mathematics, analytical aptitude and ability to observe and distinguish patterns and to test the basic knowledge of the candidates in English/Hindi. The questions will be set both in Hindi and English. The papers can be answered either in Hindi or in English.

2. The rest of the instructions contained in the advertisement earlier circulated by the Dy Inspector General, Training Centre and School during the month of June 2009 to fill-up 413 vacancies of CT/GD (Male) in BSF will remain unchanged.

1. Applications are invited from the MALE candidates belonging to JHARKHAND STATE for the post of Constable(GD) in BSF on temporary basis likely to be permanent in the pay scale of Rs.5,200/- 20,200/- with grade pay of Rs. 2,000/- plus usual and admissible allowances to Central Government Employees from time to time. In addition, ration allowances, medical assistance, free uniform, free accommodation, free leave pass etc, are admissible to BSF. The post has All India liability and selected candidate can be posted any where in India and even abroad. They will be governed under BSF Act & Rules as well as CCS Rules.

2. The selected candidates on appointment shall be entitled the pension benefits as per the 'NEW RESTRUCTURED DEFINED CONTRIBUTORY PENSION SCHEME' applicable for the new entrants to the Central Government Service with effect from 1st Jan, 2004.

3. Details of vacancies released/notified which may vary/alter on administrative reasons, are as under :-

10% of the vacancies irrespective of reservation quota as mentioned above, are reserved for Ex-Servicemen, which may later on be filled up by fresh candidates if suitable Ex-Servicemen do not turn up.

4. **ELIGIBILITY CONDITION FOR THE POST OF CONST (GD).**

- Age** - Between 18 to 23 years as on 01 Aug 2009
Upper age limit is relaxable by 3 years for OBC
and 5 years for SC/ST candidates.
- Education** - Minimum Matriculation or equivalent

Note:- Men belonging to hill areas should produce hill area certificate issued by concerned state Authority at the time of recruitment so that they can take benefits in height.

5. **MEDICAL STANDARD FOR CONSTABLE (GD) MALE CANDIDATES.**

Eye sight: The minimum distance vision should be 6/6 and 6/9 both eyes without glasses. The candidate must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes and they should possess high colour vision. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

6. ELIGIBILITY FOR RE-EMPLOYMENT OR EX-SERVICEMEN CONSTABLE(GD) ONLY.

Ex-servicemen being trained soldier, only written test, interview and Medical fitness test to ascertain Medical category will be conducted. As per Government order total relaxation in prescribed physical standard & Education is admissible. Relaxation of upper age limit to the extent of military service plus 3 years is applicable. However break in Army service and re-employment should not exceed 2 years. No PET is required to qualify by ex-servicemen.

7. Persons serving in Government /Semi Government department may send their applications through proper channel along with

'No Objection Certificate' as per format given in ANNEXURE - I

8. Wards (Sons) of serving / retired BSF personal may also apply if so desired accordingly. Sons of serving BSF personnel may apply either from their home State or from State in which his father is posted/ deployed at the time of recruitment. This concession is also applicable for serving Enrolled Followers of BSF.

9. TESTS/INTERVIEW.

(a) Physical Efficiency Test of 25 Marks Viz. 1 Mile run, 11 Ft long jump and 3 ft 6 inches High jump.

(b) Written test:- Objective type (GK) 25 marks and Descriptive type viz. Essay writing, dictation (Hindi or English) and mathematics etc. 25 marks. (Inclusion of psychological test as a part of written test (GHQ)).

(c) Interview to check personal bearing, response orientation, general level of intelligence etc. (15 marks).

(d) Medical examination as per BSF medical Manual.

- (e) Bonus marks for NCC/ITI Diploma & Certificates holders and National /State/ University level sportsmen will be given

10. **HOW TO APPLY AND BY WHICH DATE.**

Applications in the prescribed format at per Annexure - II either by type written or neatly hand written on one side only in full scape plain paper with passport size photographs affixing on application duly attested by a Gazette officer with seal be sent to **DIG, TC&S, BSF, Meru, Hazaribag (Jharkhand)** super scribing on the envelop "**APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF CONSTABLE(GD) IN BSF, DISTRICT _____**" so as to reach not later than **31 Jul 2009** through ordinary post along with following documents:-

- (a) Postal order for Rs.50/- payable in favour of **DIG, TC&S, HZB**. In case of Bank Draft, same should be in favor of **DIG, TC&S BSF Hazaribag payable at SBI MERU BAZAR code No. 2922** otherwise the application will be rejected. However, no postal order/Demand Draft is required for SC/ST candidates and Ex-servicemen.
- (b) Candidates are requested to fill up application form in Hindi or English language.
- (c) Attested copies of certificate/ testimonials as proof of Educational qualification and age/date of birth.
- (d) Attested copy of Caste/Category certificate for SC/ST/OBC candidates issued by an officer not below Tehsildar or SDO/SDM etc.
- (e) Attested copy of Domicile Certificate issued by an officer not below Tehsildar or SDO/SDM etc.
- (f) One self addressed envelop of size 23 x10 cms affixed with Postage stamp for Rs. 5/- bearing name and full postal address of the candidate with Pin code.

- (g) A form for issue of Admit card will also be filled in and forwarded along with Passport size photograph as per Annexure - III along with the application form duly attested by a Gazetted Officer with seal.
- (h) Envelope containing Applications must be subscribed in bold letters as "APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF CONSTABLE (GD) IN BSF"

11. SELECTION PROCESS FOR CONSTABLE (GD).

Admit card with roll number and general instructions for appearing for test/interview will be issued 15 days prior to the date of test/interview to the eligible candidates. They will be called to appear for the same to a place preferably within their Home State for which no TA/DA is admissible. Incomplete application will be summarily rejected and no correspondence on this will be entertained.

NO APPLICATION AFTER 31 Jul 2009 WILL BE ACCEPTED.
